Rock Masters tournament in Gibraltar drops GUARANTEED prize fund figure

The Rock Masters tournament in Gibraltar next month seems to have lowered the "Guaranteed" price fund. The £30,000 guarantee has shrunk to £10,000. It just appears as a change on the tournament web site at <http://rockmasters.eu/35.html>, and as a note on the ISBT web site.

The info on Rockmasters.eu site states

At present, Sat 22nd Oct 2011, the confirmed entry to the Tournament does not allow the original Prize Fund of £30,000 to be made available.

The Tournament has been re-sanctioned by ETBF and the available Prize Fund is as follows:

60 or more Bowlers £10,000

80 or more Bowlers £15,000.

There are a significant number of Bowlers who have entered the Tournament but have yet to confirm their entry with payment. There are many others who have indicated they are intending to enter but have not yet done so.

It would help both the organisers and Bowlers who have entered if those intending to enter do so without further delay.

So the question must be when is a Guaranteed prize fund a Guaranteed prize fund??

As you can see below the entry form clearly states the prize fund as guaranteed. Maybe you senior bowlers out there can give us your views on this change or if you didnt know of the changes you should do now.
